1. In Normal circumstances and conditions and in order to minimise financial risks, of whatsoever sort, DDRA set limits, parameters and regulations to be concerned with physical cash and financial dealings;
2. The practice and order of dealings, to date, has been that no more than SDG 500 (five hundred Sudanese pounds) of cash is either physically cashed to a payee or legitimate recipient nor is kept in office safes. Any payable sums exceed that amount are issued in cheques forms in the name/s of those legitimated as recipients;
3. Unfortunately, conditions have now changed – access to physical cash is now limited by national regulations (laws) and that neither us nor or partners can access cash at request. This upsets our work and the way we intend to do things;
4. We therefore intend to make it possible of our personnel and partners to keep sums that speedily help do work and move thing –hence this new waiver;
5. Effectively, As of today, ceiling for cash payment, or keeping in office safes, is SDG 20,000 (twenty thousand Sudanese pounds);
6. Any new conditions shall be met will review of considerations necessary;
7. Managers and those authorised shall put this in effect accordingly and all at once.
